Season 2024 Fees

For 2024 all fees will be required to be at the time of registering. If for any reason your child doesn't end up playing, a reimbursement will be arranged.

Players with outstanding fees from 2023 will not be registered until those fees are paid in full.

The club has set fees for 2024 as follows:

- 1st player in family - \$285
- 2nd and subsequent players in family - \$275

Families who are eligible for 'Ticket to Play' must register for this BEFORE registering their player for the season.

2024 season will commence on 5/6 of April for U8, U9, U10, U12, U14, U16 & U17 with 2 weeks of seeding rounds. Once seeding rounds are complete season will commence 26/27 April.
